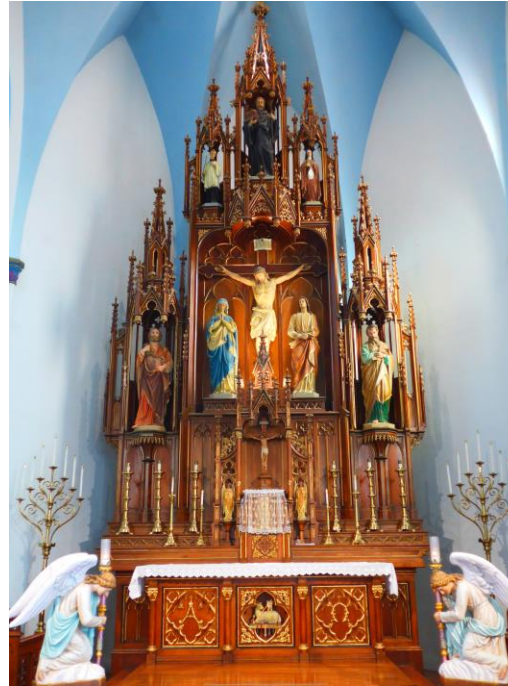




1) **St. Joseph** holding the baby Jesus: *Patron of the Universal Church.* 2) Mural of **“Christ the Good Samaritan.”**

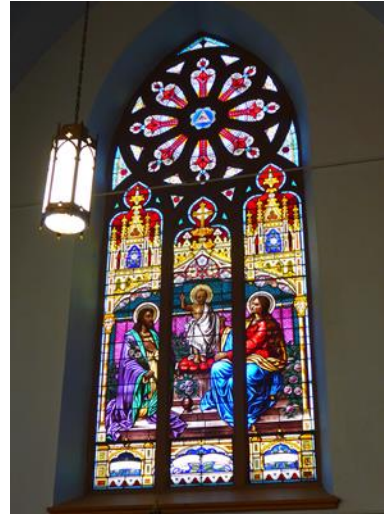

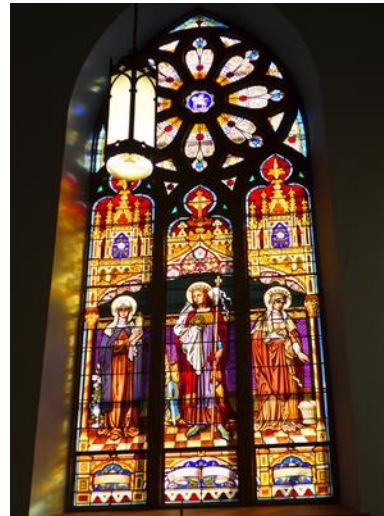
